The Adolescent Medicine Trials Network for HIV Interventions (ATN) is the only network in the United States dedicated solely to HIV research among adolescents and young adults in the United States. The ATN is comprised of over 40 universities, healthcare providers, and community organizations.

The ATN conducts innovative and collaborative research that explores promising strategies to support sexual health among adolescents and young adults ages 13-24.
